

Uplands Park School Code of Conduct for “All” (Code of Cooperation)

Our aim is to establish and maintain a safe, caring, orderly and inclusive environment where learning is valued and differences are accepted. Our code will clarify and communicate expectations for conduct while at school, while going to and from school, while at a school related activity, or in other circumstances where engaging in the activity will have an impact upon the school environment. We value diversity by showing acceptance and respect and uphold the B.C. Human Rights Code in our actions. Individuals who have special needs may require appropriate adaptations of our disciplinary code to respect those differences in order to meet the goal of a safe, caring, orderly and inclusive environment.

I. Conduct Expectations and Acceptable Conduct

- Showing empathy for the feelings of others
- Respecting self, others, and the school
- Helping to make the school a safe, caring, orderly and inclusive place
- Reporting, in a timely manner, any incidents where the safety or well being of another person is at risk. This includes acts of bullying, harassment or intimidation.
- Engaging in purposeful learning activities in a timely manner
- Acting in a manner that brings credit to the individual and pride to their family and school

Citizenship

We expect everyone to be polite at school, respectful of others, dressed appropriately, and to arrive at school each day ready to learn.
