**Daily attendance:** a proven factor for success in school, however, if **your child is ill or unable to attend school on that day, please call the office before 9:00am.** We also ask that your child **arrive at school after 8:25 am** unless there is a specific school reason to be here earlier. Our morning supervision begins at 8:25 am and we want to ensure that the students are safe. If your child arrives after 8:45 am, please have them **sign in at the front of the school** with our secretary. If you need to pick your child up early for an appointment, please make sure to write a note in your child's planner or contact the office. We want to ensure we know when you are arriving as students may or may not be in their homeroom class and we want to make sure your child is ready when you arrive. Thank you for understanding.
