#### **New Criminal Record Check Process**

All school districts in B.C. will be following Provincial Guidelines for the Criminal Record Check Process. This means that the link to the online form as well as special code will no longer be available in Administrative Procedure 310 - Volunteer. By completing the online application, you agree to the terms and conditions for the CRRP Applicant Based Online Service to facilitate a criminal record check and to share the completed criminal record check information with Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools.

- Only need your BC Services Card for identity verification
- First time users will be directed to activate their card by video or in person through Service BC
- No cost to apply
- To activate and use your BC Services Card, you must verify your identity. Available options include Verify Your Identity by Video (through a video call or by sending a video) or Verify Your Identity in Person.
- If individuals do not have a BC Services Card, they will be re-directed to the current Equifax process (during transition period only, as this will be phased out) or to fill out manually Once you have verified your identity, eCRC Online service, begin the application process:
- Website: https://justice.gov.bc.ca/criminalrecordcheck
- Access Code: UQ4T7XXBHE

Once you have completed the online application, the Ministry of Justice will forward a copy to our District office where it will be put into our district database of volunteers. Your school has access to view this database and will be able to confirm that your criminal record check has been approved and completed. This process can take up to three weeks or more in some cases. If you are having any problems with your submission, please contact your school for assistance.

#### **Moving**

#### PROGRESS REPORTS

Formal report cards will be issued **February 4.** Teachers have been and will continue to provide **Ongoing Communicate Student Learning** (OCSL) to you in a variety of ways through work samples sent home in paper form or electronically, or Celebrations of Learning. Our teachers have been working very hard together to create templates and samples of student learning that will clearly inform you of your students' ongoing progress and achievements at school.

Remember, in OCSL you can expect to see 1) Learning Outcomes (curricular competencies) that the students are practicing, 2) descriptive feedback from teachers regarding student work, 3) student self-reflection, 4) real-time samples of everyday work.

#### **Student Drop Off/Pick Up**

We continue to urge parents/families to exercise caution when dropping off or picking up children. When you are dropping off/picking up children, please keep physical distance (2 metres) in accordance with COVID-19 protocols and/or <u>wear a mask</u>. We would ask that you encourage students that are able, to walk independently to the lineup. If you are staying after school for your child to play on the playground, please keep distance and/or wear a mask. Adults without masks should not be near students. Thanks for helping to keep our school community as safe as possible.

#### **Nut/Scent Aware**

A reminder that Uplands Park Elementary is a nut and scent aware school. Please do not send your child to school with nuts or nut butters and please avoid wearing strong perfume or cologne. Thank you for helping to keep our students and staff safe.

#### **School Closures**

We are getting into that time of year when the weather is getting colder and the risk of snow is greater. If schools are closed due to snow, or any other weather-related problems, announcements will be made on local radio stations (WOLF 106.9 FM, WAVE 102.3 FM, and 91.7 COAST FM) by 7 a.m. on the day of the closure. Please do not call the radio station – tune in and listen for the announcements, which will be made on a regular basis. In addition, the district will post the information on the district's website, Twitter, Facebook, and mobile app. Please keep in mind, however, that there may be situations where this is not always possible, for example, power outages or technical problems. The most reliable method is to listen to the local radio stations.
